Finding a quorum present and finding this regularly scheduled meeting of the Arch Hurley Conservancy District's Board of Directors duly advertised, as required by statute, President Lopez called this meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. in the District Office.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE AND INVOCATION

The Pledge of Allegiance was lead by President Robert Lopez and the Invocation was given by Phillip Box.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES – REGULAR SCHEDULED MEETING May 14, 2019

Director Perkins made the motion to approve the draft minutes of the Arch Hurley Conservancy District's May 14, 2019, regular meeting. The motion was seconded by Director Mitchell. Motion carried 5-0.

MANAGER'S REPORT

Today the Conchas Lake elevation is at 4,185.6 feet. Last year at this time the elevation of Conchas Lake was 4,195.3 feet. Conchas Lake received 17,911 acre feet of inflow for the month of May and evaporation and other losses were 3,599-acre feet. Releases for AHCD in May was 8,754 cfs.

On May 17, Michelle Jaynes attended the ICIP training in Las Vegas that was hosted by DFA.

In the Board's packet, there are copies of emails to crop insurance companies regarding Arch Hurley's water allocation.

The seepage from the canal just below check 3 has increased from last year. We have ordered another semi load of bentonite. This area will be worked on after the end if the water run. We have ordered more copper sulfate to treat the moss and algae in the canals and laterals. We will pick it up in Albuquerque this week.

On May 20, Arch Hurley had 3 vehicles that was damaged in the hail storm. Last week an insurance adjuster came to inspect the vehicles and estimated the damage to be \$12,110.00.

On May 23, Arch Hurley acquired two CD's from Citizens Bank. One CD @ \$100,000.00 and the other CD was \$50,000.00. They are a one-year CD with the interest rate of 2.313%.

Donna Lafferty and Tina Garcia attended a workshop in Tucumcari this month that was put on by the N.M. Attorney General's staff. It was reviewing the Open Meetings Act and Inspection of Public Records Act.

The Ditch Riders have not had any vandalism or unauthorized gate changes in the delivery system last month. Two of our laterals are chained and locked.

Director Perkins asked if the water flow in the seepage area would allow for an effective application of the bentonite. Manager McCasland stated that a minimal amount of the bentonite will be applied to test for effectiveness.

Director Lopez asked if the aquatic weeds were present in the canals. Manager McCasland stated that the moss had returned to the lower portion of the Hudson and the Conchas and some of the laterals.

REVIEW CONCHAS LAKE ELEVATION AND REVIEW WATER ALLOCATION

Manager McCasland stated that the elevation of Conchas Lake is 4,185.6. Director Perkins made the motion to not allocate any additional water at this time. The motion was seconded by Director Mitchell. Motion carried 5-0.
