MANAGER'S REPORT

Today the Conchas Lake elevation is at 4,161.9 feet. Last year at this time the elevation of Conchas Lake was 4,160.7 feet. Conchas Lake received 638 acre-feet of inflow for the month of March. The evaporation and other losses were 1,934 acre-feet. The snowpack on the Canadian Basin as of March 7, 2023, is at 8% above normal. Last year at this time it was 25% below normal.

On March 23rd, the BOR sent two individuals from the BOR Denver office to conduct the air quality and airflow tests in the five tunnels that are planned for inspection.

The Class A assessments were mailed in March to the landowners.

AHCD Auditor, Dan Austin was here working on the 2022 audit. He is planning to be here later this month to finish and conduct the audit exit conference.

The maintenance department is working on the main canal from Conchas. They are installing some culverts in a couple of areas where the erosion is excessive.

The water department has burned A and B Units. The sewer line on the G Unit house collapsed. It has been repaired.

AHCD will have an election resolution for the board to approve at the June meeting. This will be the election for the three district board positions.

REVIEW CONCHAS LAKE ELEVATION AND YEAR-TO-DATE SNOWPACK IN THE CANADIAN BASIN. SET WATER ALLOCATION FOR 2023 IRRIGATION SEASON

Manager McCasland stated that the elevation of Conchas Lake is at 4161.9 feet. He also reviewed Snow Pack on the Canadian Basin reports with the board.

Director Griffiths made the motion not to allocate any water at this time. The motion was seconded by Director Mitchell. Motion carried 4-0.

The board will continue to review monthly snowpack reports regarding the Canadian Basin and review any stream inflow into Conchas Lake.
